At a given point in 2020, it was a very difficult situation for the world, the event industry and obviously, the people. Due to all the guidelines, everything came to a halt, and eventually, a limit. Founder of Saltt and chef Sammir S Gogia's experience and experiments make this 15-year-old legacy a top choice for weddings and more

"Many people have asked me what's my expansion plan? I've done everything one can possibly do in this line". Gogia's family history with food dates back to half a century when his forefathers established Halls ketchup and tinned fruits.

On being asked what makes Saltt a leader amongst their contemporaries, he states three rationales of experience, love for food, and consistency. The brand is all about experimenting with food with perfection. And that has been its point of excellence courtesy to Gogia and his brother Sachin. His rendezvous with food began early in college when he began assisting his father at Utsav Greens. What intrigued him was the opportunity to create new dishes and meet new people, and he absolutely loved it. Being a wedding-season

favourite, it has a reputation for stirring up wildest-lipsmacking food combinations. Their quirky and unique creations include Activated charcoal gol gappa with Wasabi curd, Waffle aloo tikki, and Dahi bhalla ice cream.

For couples planning their big celebrations, Gogia advises to always go for food trials. "You should have a comfortable rapport with them, they understand your food, your palette, and is able to produce what you want to eat".

The entity is all about providing extraordinary gastronomic experiences. And one would certainly wonder if they have any plans of going global after conquering the Indian market. "At the spur of the moment, no. It's not about expanding but going into the depth of it. So global right now? Not in my plan". It is indeed great to know that Gogia has his priorities set, all on the Indian market.

To learn more about how this industry works and its importance, we spoke with Touchwood Entertainment Group's senior event planner Pallavi Batra to help you decide upon the wedding entruster.

Why her? Being in the industry for almost a decade, Batra leaves no stone unturned for her clients. She's at the helm of affairs allied with all the parties and has an exquisite knowledge about bars and beverages for pertinent events.

Why hire an event planner? Event planners make sure you and your loved ones enjoy your wedding and celebrations as you'll not have the hassle of doing what we'll be doing for you. But ultimately, it all comes down to the clients' personal choice, whether to hire an event planner or not.

The deciding factor while finalizing a wedding planner: The vibe. A wedding is an intimate affair and a very important day for the couple. The vibe must match so that both parties can walk this journey together. Also, the credibility and capability which comes with experience and previous work they've done.

How to allocate a budget for different heads? This is a very subjective question. We need to understand what the client wants and what their taste is before we allocate a budget. There needs to be the active involvement of the clients to allocate for the broader headings, while sub-budgets can be divided by us.

When to make the first contact? The sooner, the better. When you know you are fixed, that yes this is the person I am to get married to and have your dates sorted.

How long does it ideally take to plan an event? There is no stipulated time frame. We've planned International weddings from scratch in 20 days. We've also had 10 months to plan a wedding. In case of time constraints, we get members on board for the event and make it happen.

Deciphering the perfect diamond

Diamonds have become the forever symbol of love and commitment. The commonly known attributes to ascertain the quality of the diamonds are the "Four C's": Cut, Carat, Colour and Clarity. Given the global shift towards a sustainable culture, sourcing and craftsmanship have been added to the buying decisions of diamonds. We are here to guide you through the 6 Cs and how to find the perfect diamond that suits you

Cut

Diamonds in their natural state bear no resemblance to the sparkling stone we are all familiar with. Do not confuse the cut to be the same as shape. The measurements of the angle and how well-proportioned the dimensions of a diamond are, determined by how it interacts with light. Hence, its sparkle and brilliance.

Carat

Diamond carat weight measures how much a diamond physically weighs. 1 carat is divided into 100 points so that 50 points is 0.5 carat. Large diamonds are rarer than smaller ones, as the weight of the carat increases, the value of the diamond increases as well.

Colour

Most diamonds, although appear colourless, actually have slight tones of yellow, brown or grey. Colourless diamonds are rare and therefore more expensive. Colours vary from icy white colourless to light yellow on a scale from D to Z. Diamonds with a rating of D-E-F are the most desired and rare. This is the reason it's important to compare diamonds side to side.

Clarity

Almost all diamonds contain naturally occurring internal characteristics called inclusions. Inclusions are the birthmarks that make each gem stone unique. Most of the imperfections that affect a diamond's clarity grade aren't visible to the naked eye. The size, nature, location and the amount of inclusions determine a diamond's Clarity grade. Internally Flawless (IF) is the one with the least or no inclusions. Including Grade 3 (I3) has the most inclusions which are likely to impact the beauty of diamonds being at the two ends of a spectrum.

Certification

The one advice given by the older generation is to safeguard your investments and diamonds are the most important group of gemstones in commercial terms. Certification from diamond grading labs and institutes like the International Gemological Institute (IGI) and the Gemological Institute of America (GIA) are precisely doing the same. Their certification is done to impart confidence in the diamond's quality.

Conscience

In recent years, there has been a shift in the consumer culture to understand how their products are sourced. Chief among their concerns is that workers are being compensated fairly, strict health and safety regulations are being followed and the goods are being produced with the least environmental impact possible. It only seems natural that this shift in the culture, would make its way to diamonds especially if you're shopping for the stone to commemorate an important milestone.

What's the process for designing your bride and groom collection? work on our collections keeping our clier

We work on our collections keeping our clientele in mind and understanding their expectations from us, be it the silhouettes, the material or the intricacy of each garment. We keep true to our brand DNA and language which is high on glimmer and amalgamate market requirements to suit today's demand. However, sometimes the commercial don't work. So, when I gave them my commercials it was out of their budget. But the father shared something that got me hooked He said that the only thing his daughter after her engagement asked was that she wanted to book me for her wedding. I came to know that the girl didn't have a mother and the only thing the girl wanted was Dolly. I actually didn't charge them anything. I told the father of the bride not to tell her that I am coming down for her wedding. She was getting ready for her wedding and I just told her "Hi, how are you?", and she just flipped. She recognized my voice so well that she said "Dolly Ma'am?". And I cannot tell you the kind of feelings, the kind of emotion which ran down between us. I am still connected to her. I feel all my brides have been so special to me, but there are few who are super special and so, she is one.

And I did it and I am so glad the whole world has appreciated the kind of work I have done for Natasha.

on't be foolish, you'll never The most unpredictable drape I did...was definitely of Natasha for the Met because I had no clue about it. It was definitely one of my finest works and a work where you show your creativity.

> The World Record I hold...Limca Book of World Records for 325 ways to drape. The inspiration behind my world record has definitely been, you know, to give the world a magic number that anybody doesn't even dare to break. So I first did 80 different styles of sari, then 100, 125, 225, and then 325.

What my tattoo signifies ... 'I am six yards ahead of my time' says everything about me. It says I am here, but my sari is six yards away and I am six yards ahead because I have that sari in my hand. The moment I read this line I felt so connected. I was looking to get myself inked and I didn't know what to do. But this line is all about me, this is all about my passion.

My upcoming coffee table book... is about 365+1 styles of draping a sari. The +1 is for the leap year. So, you open your wardrobe, just open my book, you just have to take out your sari, crop top, and lower. And you get a new piece of sari style every single day. I wanted to give the world a framework before I retire.

Bringing to life a concoction of Realism and the heritage of Basholi, revered artist Raghu Vyas sheds light on his journey, culture, and what his art is all about



Evocative. The word single-handedly defines what celebrated painter Raghu Vyas wants his audience to feel, wants you to feel.

He has captivated aesthetes with his artworks for over four decades. And has dabbled in abstract, landscapes, and numerous forms, before settling his heart on the Realism technique of the Italian Renaissance.

Vyas proudly brings to the table the true essence of Basholi through his paintings. The miniature style of artwork, though being a part of the Mughal culture, finds its origins in Iran. The art technique travelled to India during the Mughal period and inspired many under the rule of Aurungzeb. Soon the artists were exiled by the Alamgir and found shelter under the Pahadi Maharaj's. This gave birth to the flourishing period of *Basholi* paintings for 200 years.

While Vyas may not have received any formal training in painting, his biggest inspirations are what keep him going. Raja Ravi Varma and Rembrandt have played a major role in influencing the

style of this recipient of the Raja Ravi Varma Awards. Calling the legendary Dutch artist his treasured painter, he has also produced a self-portrait in the Rembrandt style.

What drew him to the world of photorealism over contemporary or modern styles was strength. "Realism has a very strong strength where it conveys a message to the society. and the people understand well", the realism technique metamorphosed for 400 years under the likes of Raphael, Rubens, and Botticelli.

He has been acknowledged and applauded for his curations on a wide range of subject matters, be it the Krishna series, Buddha series, Sikh history, or gods and goddesses. While he has kept his domain specialisation limited to Indian history and culture, what broke the wall and made him recreate The Three Graces was the Hollywood actress Nicole Kidman. It represents beauty, creativity, and fertility. While there have been several reiterations of the historical oil painting in Europe, Vyas is the only artist in India to have made "The Three Graces".

On being asked about his mostcherished artworks, he picks not one but two- the Ram Rajyabhishek and Shiva. It took him six months to recreate the former 7x7 piece of Raja Ravi Varma, but made use of bright colours and tweaked the overall architecture. While Shiva's visual beauty lies in its compelling narration of the whole universe.

His under-progress series is an amalgamation of diverse concepts and abundant imagination. Vyas wishes to exhibit the fine works he has in mind to his audience in upcoming years.

But being a woman, there can be certain situations where wearing a tampon or a pad is just not pleasing. There are pills available and you can start taking them about 10 days before your estimated date. You can continue consuming the pills till the time you don't want to have your periods. But be careful to not use it often. Otherwise, your cycle can get messed up.

What is the hygiene guide that I must follow once I start having regular sexual intercourse?

I tell all my patients about the mnemonics of ABCDE. Avoid holding urine, a lot of girls end up holding urine regularly because they don't want to use the public restrooms. Whenever you are on your period and bleeding, avoid intercourse as it can increase the chances of infection. Keep your private parts clean, the cleaning process should always be front to back rather than back to front. Always keep your bottom area dry and avoid any wetness there. Lastly, always be at ease. Avoid wearing undergarments at night to keep the area loose and natural.

What kind of conversations should a person be having with their partner pre or post-intercourse?

Talk to your partner about what you want and what they desire. You must speak to your partner and not keep things to yourself. It may create a mental block for you. So let it out, relax and have a conversation
